Kungsbacka

Kungsbacka is located in the middle of the west coast very close to the second largest city in Sweden - Gothenburg. Kungsbacka is a small town of 73 000 inhabitans. The region offers unique cultural environments, exciting outings and fun activities. There are plenty of opportunities for swimming and fishing along the coast and in Lygnern, Halland's largest lake.

Kungsbacka has a vast range of fascinating visitor attractions. The three main visitor attractions are Tjolöholm Manor House, Äskhult village and Fjärås Bräcka ridge with its nature information centre.

The town centre offers shopping in a charming turn-of-the-century-setting,



Kungsmässan shopping centre has around 90 shops and Freeport, the only true factory outlet in West Sweden, promises a special shopping expericence! In Gothenburg, you can find an ample choice of night clubs, cafés and restaurants, shopping malls and boutiques, and of course tourist attractions.

About the weather in March in the southwest of Sweden – it may be full winter and it may be sunny

Getting to Kungsbacka

Kungsbacka is located 25 km south of the city of Gothenburg. It is easy to get to Kungsbacka and Elof Lindälvs gymnasium by train since there is a direct connection from the central station in Gothenburg to Kungsbacka station every 15 minutes in the morning and the afternoons and in between every half hour. Elof Lindälvs gymnasium is just a short walk from the station.

At arrival

The easiest way to get to Kungsbacka from the airport is to go by bus – the airport shuttle bus – to the central station in Gothenburg. It leaves every 20 minutes. You can buy a ticket for the bus either at the airport, in a ticket machine or at the bus (only credit card payment). You can









also buy a ticket on beforehand online to get a lower price. Follow this link: http://www.flygbussarna.se/en/landvetter.

When at the central station in Gothenburg, you take the train to Kungsbacka. You need to buy a specific ticket for this train at the SJ Ticket office (SJ Resebutik) at the central station or by using the ticket machine at the station (in that case you need a credit card). At Elof Lindälvs gymnasium students begin at 08.25 in the morning and end at 16:00. Most classes are 60 minutes long and the school is open 5 days a week (Monday till Friday). 




- TRANSPORT: You will be picked up at the hostel every morning.
